### **Return to Small Outdoor Group Training Protocols**

### 19-5-20

Returning to play community sport in a safe, hygienic and controlled manner is of paramount importance to AFL Barwon. The safety and wellbeing of all our participants and club volunteers remains our number one priority.

Following last week's Victorian State Government announcement around the return of community sport, AFL Barwon is endorsing a return to club sanctioned small outdoor group training for <u>both community football and</u> <u>netball across all age groups</u>.

AFL Barwon endorses Netball Victoria's return to **community netball** training guidelines, with clubs able to commence in a safe and cautious manner with up to groups of 10 from **Thursday, May 21**.

AFL Barwon endorses AFL Victoria's return to small outdoor group training for **community football**, with clubs able to commence in a safe and cautious manner with up to groups of 10 from **Monday**, **May 25**.

Clubs <u>can</u> resume training within the scope of the protocols, but it is not the date that they <u>must</u> start training. When, or if, a club resumes training remains entirely up to the discretion of the club.
